44% of the students who received baccalaureate or master's degrees in a STEM field attended a community college.

37% of the students enrolled in ATE-improved programs during 2007 were women.

83,400 people took at least one ATE-supported course in 2007.

2,632 educational materials - courses, modules, or activities - were developed by **57** ATE programs during 2007.

In 2007, Hispanics made up **16%** of the participants in ATE initiatives that tracked ethnicity.

49,100 educators attended ATE professional development programs in 2007, a **70%** one-year increase.
